How to place a student media enquiry

The Department of Transport's Public Affairs Branch manages communications for the department, including handling all media enquiries.

Students should submit requests to Public Affairs, emailing specific questions to ask@transport.vic.gov.au at least **five working days** before deadline. Enquiries submitted with a shorter deadline may not be answered.

Students should provide name, contact email, telephone number and university/school being attended and advise whether the request is for publication or an assignment.

The student will be advised if the department is unable to respond to the enquiry. In these instances Public Affairs will provide guidance on where the enquiry should be directed to.

The Public Affairs team welcomes your enquiries and will endeavour to facilitate all student requests; however priority is given to enquiries from media organisations.

Due to the volume of enquiries from media organisations and others, it is only possible to respond to students via email.
